Course Description:

Course Objectives:

Aiming to spread the knowledge of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) of the United Nations and to evoke the interest in international governance that promotes exchanges between different cultural backgrounds, this course provides the students with the Global perspective on SDGs. For each SDG, this course will introduce the basics, review the development status of Japan's relevant work, elaborate on case studies of Japan or other countries and regions, and discuss the potential challenges.

Learning Goals:

The students are expected to:

• (1) Master the definitions of SDGs;

• (2) Gain an understanding of Japan's work in the arena of sustainable development;

• (3) Develop analytical skills under a multi-faceted SDG framework.

Also, the students are expected to brainstorm solutions that will help realize the SDGs with their own expertise. The UN SDGs were adopted in 2015, consisting of 17 SDGs that cover the societal, economic, and environmental challenges.
