Course Description:

After the "Lost 20 years" following the collapse of the bubble economy of the 90's, and the Lehman shock in 2008, Japan is now getting through the long tunnel lead by ABENOMICS by the 2nd Abe Administration followed by Kishida's new cabinet since 2021.

Japanese history shall be illustrated from the point of economical view, and students will come to understand the overview of Japanese technology companies in the first several weeks of the class.

This class introduces Japanese technology companies and looks at the basic principles of management that have been the immortal DNA of those enterprises by picking up two major famous companies, Panasonic, and KYOCERA. Panasonic, founded by Mr. Konosuke Matsushita, became a world-famous electronics company. KYOCERA, founded by Mr. Kazuo Inamori, has become one of the top firms in the field of electrical Fine Ceramic components. Those companies have their own original management philosophy in common, and students will come to understand the key points of these philosophies.

This class includes Field Trips to visit some technology companies. Students are expected to be positive to get valuable experiences through real activities.
