For the purpose of open presentations, discussions, and communications on the creativity & innovation methodology TRIZ and related topics, the 'Collaborative Board of TRIZ Promoters and Users in Japan' is going to hold 'The First TRIZ Symposium in Japan'. Thanks for about 20 contributions from Japan and over the world, the Symposium will be one of the major TRIZ meetings in the world this year. #### • Purposes:

- ♦ To penetrate and promote the creativity & innovation methodology TRIZ and its related areas.
- ❖ To provide a meeting opportunity for various people who are interested in TRIZ (including its related areas), such as users in industries/universities/etc., researchers, teachers, public sector people, developers & vendors of tools, publishers, consultants,
- ♦ To extend the understanding, research, application, penetration, promotion, development, etc. of TRIZ.
- **♦** To enhance the communication and integration between TRIZ and its relevant areas.
- To provide opportunities for open presentations, discussions, demonstrations, and communications.
- ♦ To encourage cooperative personal relationships among people, by offering chances of formal and informal communications during the stay at a resort hotel facility.
- To make the presentations public in the forms of oral presentations, proceedings/ hand-outs, and later Web postings, etc.
- To accept presentations and participants not only from Japan but also from other countries, and to promote international communications. For this purpose the official languages are set to be Japanese and English.

- **♦** Opening Speeches: On the Symposium, and On the Collaborative Board
- ♦ Keynote Speeches: Toru Nakagawa (OGU) and Darrell Mann (UK)
- ♦ Oral presentations: 12 contributed papers (3 from overseas and 9 from Japan),

30 minutes talk + 10 minutes discussion.

- ♦ Poster presentations: To be presented in parallel at booths in a hall.
  Currently 4 contributed papers (additional contributions are welcome).
- Vendor presentations and demos: Major vendor agencies will deliver their thoughts on how to apply TRIZ and how to promote TRIZ in Japan, and will give demonstrations of their tools.
- ♦ Informal group discussions: 90 and 120 minutes in the evenings
- ♦ Discussion: At the Closing session, on how to introduce, promote, and apply TRIZ in Japan.
- Official language: Japanese and English.

Interpreter services will not be provided as a rule.

- Proceedings: Proceedings of all the presentations will be published in Japanese
   (including Japanese translations of most English presentations)
   In English, Abstracts of all the presentations will be bounded and distributed at the Symposium; Presentations in English will be printed in the Proceedings.
- Scale: About 100 participants are expected.
