2) **“Idea” (Being)**: System Object

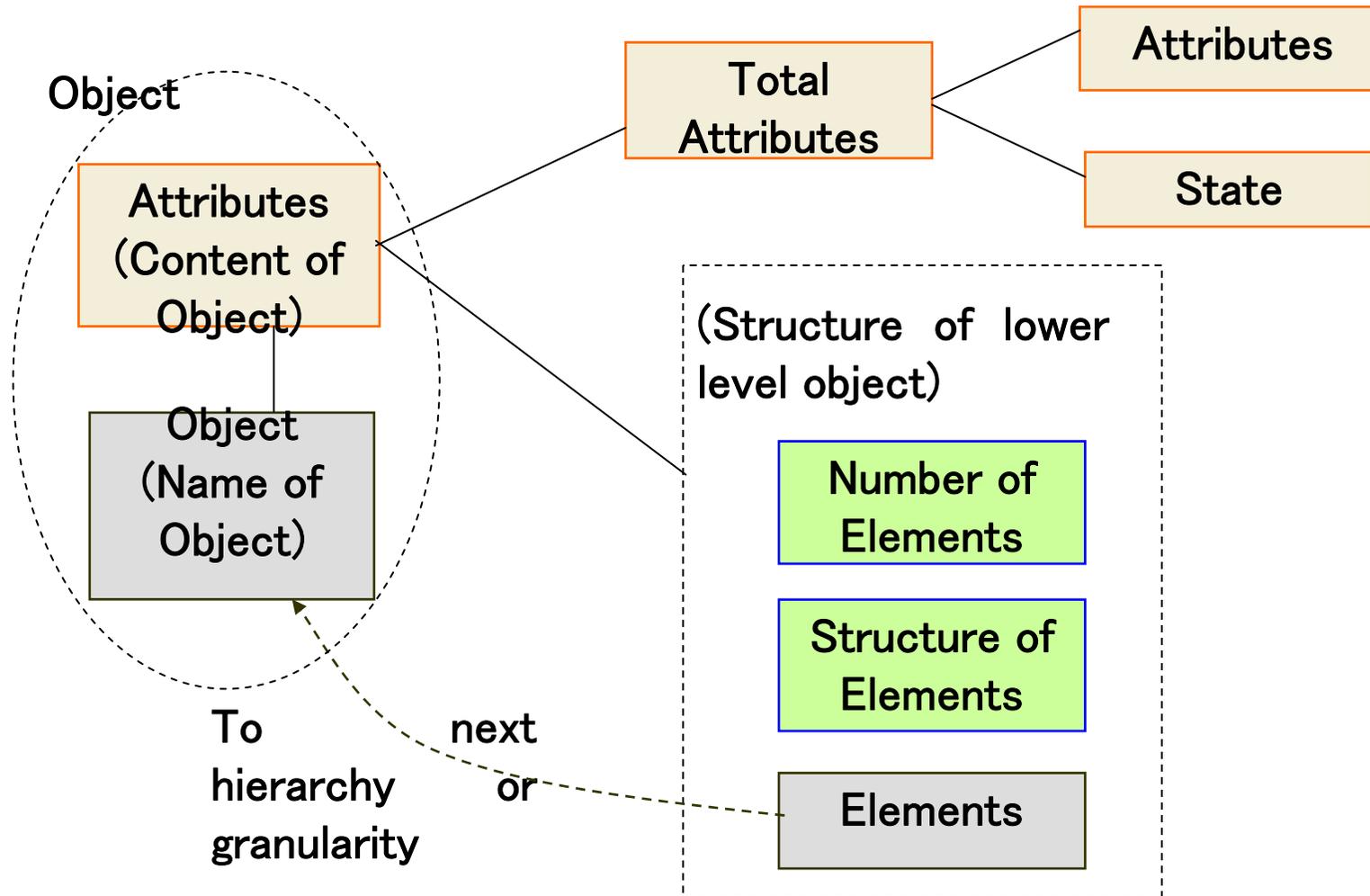
3) **Movement or Action**: Process Object

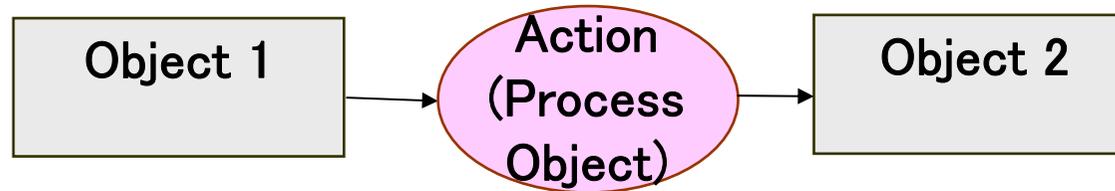
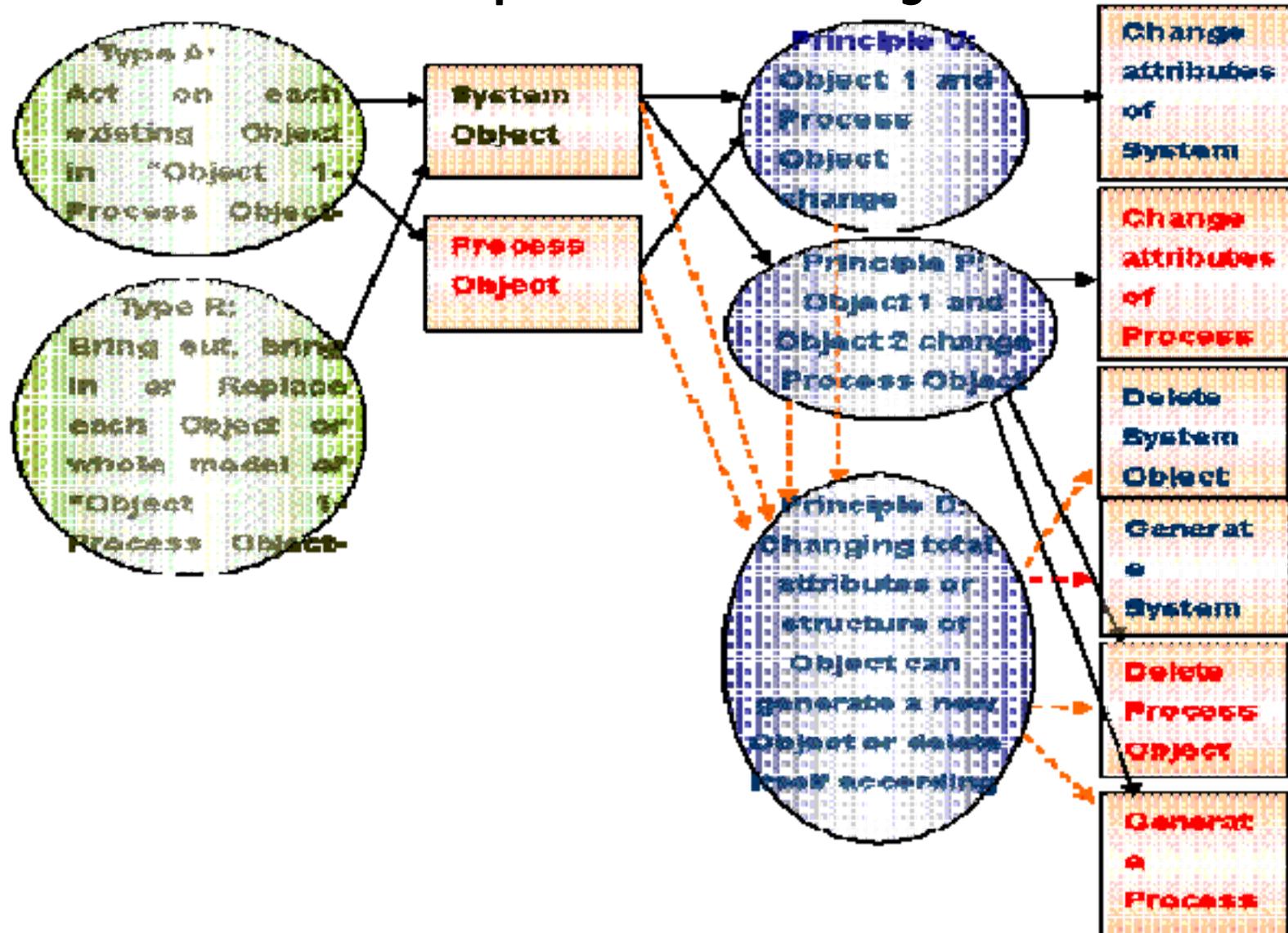


Figure 6. Object 1 and Process Object Change Object 2

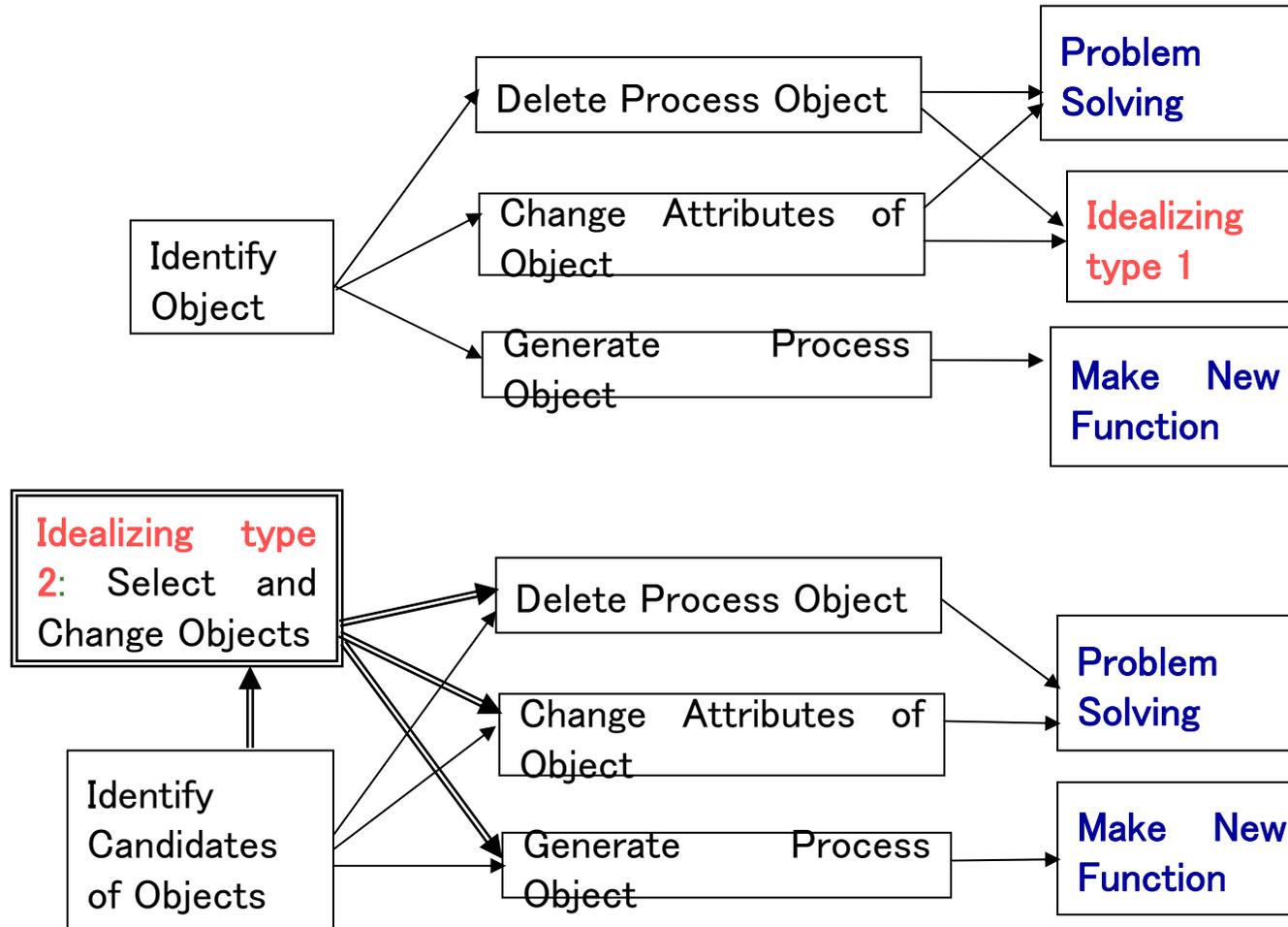


Figure 8. Object 1 and Object 2 Change Process Object

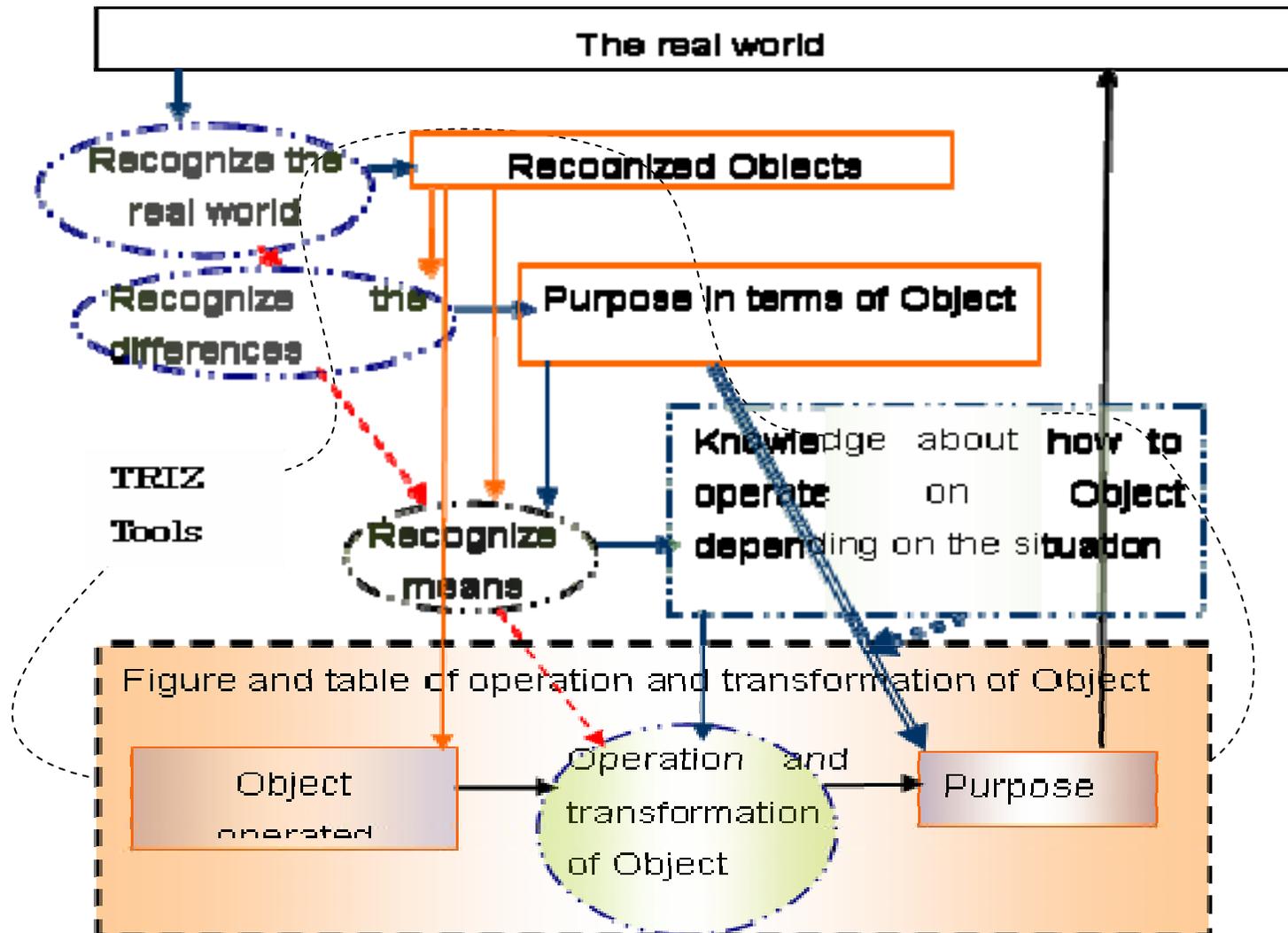
